

What is the evaluation?

In the evaluation, One Community, One Family is asking:

- Are we doing a good job helping kids and families?
- How can we do a better job?



To find out the answers to their questions, One Community, One Family has asked the evaluation team from Indiana University to help.

The evaluation team will ask people about services they've received and whether or not things have gotten better for their family and children.

Many of the questions are like these:

- *Does your family have more time to spend together?*
- *Is your child doing better in school?*
- *Is your family less stressed because of services they've received?*
- *Is your child staying out of trouble?*



If you want to know more about what happens during the interview, you can ask your caregiver or an evaluation team member questions about it.



The evaluation and you



Your caregiver might be in the One Community, One Family evaluation. If so, someone from the evaluation team will meet with your caregiver and ask questions about you and your family.

Some of these questions are private and personal, but don't worry—your information will be kept safe, and no one will see your name.



We hope you will support your caregiver if he or she decides to be in the evaluation. We are sorry that you can't be in the evaluation now, but when you turn 11, you can be. We look forward to getting to know you better then!
